## **OLYMPICS**

1. **What are the colors of the Olympic rings?**  
Blue, Black, Red, Yellow and Green
2. **How many times has the United States hosted the Summer Olympic Games?**  
Four times. (1904, 1932, 1984, 1996)
3. **What was the first team sport to be added to the modern Olympic games?**  
The **FIRST** team sport added to the Olympics was Football in 1900.
4. **Several months before the Olympic games begin, the Olympic torch is lit. What country ignites the torch every Olympic games?**  
The Olympic flame is lit at Olympia, Greece. This ceremony starts the Olympic torch relay, which formally ends with the lighting of the Olympic cauldron during

the opening ceremony of the Olympic Games. The flame then continues to burn in the cauldron for the duration of the Games, until it is extinguished during the Olympic closing ceremony.

- 5. Women first competed in the modern Summer Olympics in what year? (+/- 5)**  
1900 Paris Games with the inclusion of women's events in lawn tennis and golf. Women's athletics and gymnastics debuted at the 1928 Olympics
